## Silent Knight Farenhyt IFP 1000 "Perfect Fit" for Camellia Gardens Retirement Center



When choosing a fire protection system for the premier retirement center, Camellia Gardens of Slidell, LA, Billy Barnes of Advantage Fire Specialists of New Orleans, LA (formerly known as Freedom Alarm), felt that Silent Knight's Farenhyt IFP-1000VIP was a "perfect fit" for the new construction project. The IFP-1000VIP is an integrated analog/addressable fire control panel with built in voice evacuation capabilities.

"This job had a little bit of everything and was a perfect fit for Silent Knight," said Barnes. "We used every available function of the IFP-1000VIP."

The Farenhyt IFP-1000VIP includes appliance circuits that can be programmed for notification outputs or auxiliary power. In the case of Camellia Gardens, the circuits are utilized to run a variety of equipment: two 5815XL expanders provide 365 points of usage throughout the six-building facility. RPS-1000 power supplies are used to power horns and strobes in the main hallways. SD500-PS pull stations are located in all exits, and SD505-AHS heat detectors in all kitchens. SD500-AIM input modules monitor duct detectors and gate valves. The SD500-ARM is used to release door holders and for elevator capture.

Camellia Gardens management is pleased with the system because it's convenient and easy for nurses to help monitor fire alarms through the use of two RA-1000 annunciators located at their stations. And because the Farenhyt IFP-1000VIP voice evacuation system is scalable from 50 to 400 watts, the system can grow if the retirement center does.
