High-Capacity Fire Fighters Telephone System Judged to "...Make a Difference in Government Security"

NORTHFORD, Conn. – [Silent Knight](#) by Honeywell (NYSE: HON) celebrates winning the Platinum Award in the Fire/Life Safety category of the "[Govies](#)" Government Security Awards competition. The [Farenhyt IFP-FFT](#) Fire Fighters Telephone System from Silent Knight earned the top product designation for its large capacity, ease of integration and cost-saving features.

"The Govies are a young product awards contest considering all contests that are available, but this year's entries are mature products that fully make a difference in government security," said Ralph C. Jensen, editor-in-chief of *Security Products* magazine and content director of GovSec. The *Security Products'* Govies competition aims to honor outstanding government security products across a number of categories. This year, the IFP-FFT was one of 64 products considered.

The capability to support up to 72 telephone connections with as many as 10 phones in use at one time makes the [IFP-FFT](#) one of the industry's largest-capacity fire fighter communications systems. Being a fully supervised system, trouble conditions are immediately detected and displayed on the SK-FFT's main panel which fire fighters also utilize to control local and remote handsets.

To reduce expenses and simplify installation, Silent Knight designed the Farenhyt IFP-FFT system to operate on a single loop of standard wire. This high-capacity, lower-cost system is ideal for high-rise buildings and large facilities in regions that require fire fighter telephone systems.
